Amendments to the WSA competition Rules

Amend Article 2.4 of the WSA Slingshot Competition Rules (2025 Supplementary Edition) to allow two separate categories for men and women in the adult competition, with the same rules and stages, including the final.

Amend Article 2.6 of the WSA Slingshot Competition Rules to read as follows: "There are two rounds in the team competition: Preliminaries and Final.

The preliminary round consists of two rounds of 5 shots at 4 cm targets. All teams participate in this round.

The 8 teams with the highest scores advance to the next round.

The Final consists of 3 rounds of 5 shots at 4 cm targets (15 shots total):

1st: Top 8 teams

2nd: Top 4 teams

3rd: Top 2 teams

In the event of a tie during any stage, it will be resolved with an extra round.

All points are cumulative from the preliminary phase. Each participating country has one team, composed of the four best competitors from that country's precision competition.

The list will be published on-site and competitors cannot be replaced. The combined score of the four competitors is the team's total score.

If there's a tie between two or more teams, the teams will compete in an additional round until a winner is determined.

N.B. for the team final at least 8 shooting lines will be necessary so that two teams can shoot simultaneously

Amend Article 4.3 of the WSA Slingshot Competition Rules (2025 Supplementary Edition) to read as follows: 4.3 The practice, waiting, and competition areas must be properly separated. The practice and competition areas must have a minimum lighting level of 500 lux.

The competition area, at the shooting line, must provide a minimum free space of 1 meter per shooter, with a buffer zone of at least 0.5 meters between each shooting station.

Depending on the venue's layout, reasonable entry and exit points must be established, along with clear circulation paths, to ensure the safe, efficient, and orderly conduct of the event.
